DESCRIPTION



MUSÉE D'ORSAY

Installed in the extraordinary building that was the former Orsay train station, this national museum presents Western art from 1848 to 1914 in all its diversity. This huge, open, luminous space on the bank of the Seine combines collections from the Louvre, the Jeu de Paume and the Musée National d'Art moderne.

SAINT GERMAIN DES PRÈS

Art-lovers will be delighted in Saint Germain des Prés. A profusion of galleries offer a wide choice of works by contemporary artists. Paintings, engravings, sculpture... There's something to suit all tastes.

JARDIN DU LUXEMBOURG

This has certainly been the Parisians' favourite park for some time now, with its 29ha of greenery, ornamental ponds and splendid trees. A true French-Style garden, adjacent to the Senate building.
