THE EIFFEL TOWER

Deluxe drivers will lead you to our pride: The Eiffel tower. The tower was built by the engineer Gustave Eiffel for the Universal Exhibition of 1889, comprises three floors and is 317 meters high. On top are radio and television transmitters serving Paris.

NOTRE DAME

Notre Dame de Paris, which was built between 1163 and 1330, is a masterpiece of French Gothic art. It was restored during the 19th century by Viollet-le-Duc, who performed similar work on many of France's finest historic buildings. Your limousine will wait for you as you experience this Catholic symbol.

MONTMARTRE

Work on this basilica, which is built in the Byzantine style, started in the late 19th century and was completed in 1914. Montmartre was a village frequented by painters, sculptors and poets. Magnificient panoramic view extending 50 kilometers around Paris.

L'ARC DE TRIOMPHE

Symbol of the Napoleonic epic. A magnificent view over Paris, with the twelve famous avenues, including the Champs Elysees, radiating out from the triumphal arch. A vidéo detailling the Arc de Triomphe's finest hours is shown every ten minutes.

THE PANTHEON (LATIN QUARTER)

Deluxe Drivers will drive you to The Pantheon, this building which was transformed by Soufflot (1712-1780), was formerly the church of Saint Genevieve. Since the French Revolution, it has been the final resting place of a select group of individuals who served France in exceptional ways.

LES INVALIDES

Your limousine chauffeur driven car will lead you to The Hotel des Invalides, which was founded by Louis XIV to provide care for wounded soldiers, stands on a vast esplanade. It houses the tomb of th Emperor Napoleon, as well as a number of museums, including the military museum.

LE LOUVRE

The building of the Grand Louvre, which saw the installation of the pyramid, is 800 years old. It was a medieval castle that became a palace for the Monarchs of France. It is now the largest museum in the world. If the treasures of the Louvre were to be summed up in a smile, it would be that of the Mona Lisa, La Joconde who continues to seduce millions of visitors.
