TOURRETTES SUR LOUP

Stroll in the narrow streets of the *City of the violets* to see the tiny fashioned shops with original artists and craftsmen productions.

GOURDON

Ancient perched village (alt.2274 feet) Gourdon sits on the edge of a rocky spur above the Loup River.

From the village you'll be charmed by the best view of the Riviera. Take time out to discover the local arts and crafts, stained glass, silk painting, perfumes, soaps, honey, nougat, traditional breads ... and then a promenade to enjoy the charm of one of the numerous small squares or some of its ancient houses with their sculptured doorways.

GRASSE

On the Route Napoleon this Old Provencal town is the capital of the Perfumes. Enjoy a guided visit of the perfume factory FRAGONARD to discover all the secrets of the perfume creation. Whichever you chose you will be delighted by the charm of the old squares, the outdoor markets, the fountains and the winding streets.
