MENTON

Located at the extreme south east of France, Menton is all at once a city of gardens, a seaport and a beach resort. Its exceptional sunlight and the subtropical climate make Menton ideal for growing orange trees, lemon trees, palm trees, and Mimosa. Lemon is the symbol of this old city that hides at the end of fabulous staircases some antiques church, stone mosaics and ceramics murals.

MONACO MONTE CARLO

Monaco was built on the rocks 200 ft. above the sea. Walk in the narrow streets of the old town and see the changing of the guards just before midday in front of the palace. Visit the neo-Romanesque cathedral with the Princess Grace Memorial. City tour of Monte-Carlo. Drive on the Monte-Carlo race track. Stop at the most famous casino surrounded by beautiful gardens. Luxurious shops, flowered terraces...

EZE VILLAGE

Medieval perched village on a rocky outcrop overlooking the sea, Eze village is a pedestrian area with Small narrow roads, archways and superbly restored stone houses, shady squares, refreshing ancient fountains... you will soon be seduced by the marvels of Eze. You can also have a wonderful stop in the perfume factory Fragonard.
