THE CITIES DESCRIPTION



VILLEFRANCHE SUR MER

Villefranche sur Mer is situated right in the heart of the most beautiful and richest part of the Riviera. It's here that the most splendid properties are hidden away, and where the world's millionaires love to spend their holidays. Its superb harbour is known to be one of the most exclusive spots on the Côte d'Azur.

CAGNES SUR MER

Close from the sea, perched on the hill, overhanging the area, Cagnes as been built on a wooded landscape with olive trees, palms ... The painters were attracted by this place for its charm and bright atmosphere (Cezanne, Renoir, Modigliani...) The medieval quarter is full of tiny streets, stairs, little restaurants, Galleries, workshops and old houses.

ST PAUL DE VENCE

Built on its rocky outcrop and surrounded by its ramparts built on the orders of François I°, St Paul is certainly one of the most beautiful villages in Provence. The beauty of the surrounding area, quality of life and exceptional light has inspired numerous famous artists, painters, writers and poets, some of whom took up residence in the village.
